Rodolfo Morales

Morales was born in Oaxaca, Mexico where he was active as a painter and as an art teacher.

The artist was highly influenced by the magical side of his heritage and culture. He painted with vivid colors and incorporated elements of Magic Realism and Surrealism in his works. Artists as Marc Chagall have been mentioned often as influences on his characteristic style. Morales felt a close connection with his country and community. He has dedicated his money and legacy to the restoration of instable buildings and to educate and give scholarships to the youth of his hometown.
